Categories

Entrepreneurs can enter one of three categories and win incredible prizes:

- The Santam Rising Star title is awarded to an entrepreneur between 16 and 30 years old who is still within her first 1000 days but whose business, our judges believe, will flourish way beyond them.
- The Santam Social Entrepreneur title is awarded to an entrepreneur making a real difference in her community.

 Aged 30 or older, her business has survived the first 1000 days.

Prizes

The prizes awarded to the three winners are: R80,000 in cash to The Santam Woman of the Future; R50,000 in cash, each to the Santam Rising Star and Santam Social Entrepreneur.
